The major avenue for you to better understand and influence changes to the technical, regulatory and commercial environment in which the dental industry operates is through participation in one of the ADIA national committees:

ADIA-DRC Dental Regulation Committee

Provides feedback to the Australian Government on proposed changes to, and proposals for, legislation affecting the manufacture, importation, supply and servicing of dental equipment and therapeutic goods and medical devices.

ADIA-BAC Business Affairs Committee

Allows members to provide input to Australian Government business regulation, industrial relations and tax initiatives that have an impact on companies operating within Australia's dental industry.

ADIA-DEC Dental Exhibitions Committee

Identifies initiatives that promote the products and services of ADIA member companies via dental exhibitions, online promotions in addition to providing members with advice on the benefits of attending other dental exhibitions.

ADIA-ARC Awards & Recognition Committee

Establishes programs to promote and recognise excellence within Australia's dental industry that include the Australian Dental Industry Awards, nominations of individuals for honours and ADIA's industry service badges.

ADIA-ISC Industry Skills Committee

Reviews dental industry skills needs and works with private and public training providers to address skills shortages in addition to oversight of the successful *ADIA Introduction To Dentistry Course*.

ADIA-SSC Seminars & Conferences Committee

Sets the program for the biannual *ADIA Dental Industry Conference* in addition to the program of regional seminars and industry briefings that are held at a state / territory level.

ADIA-MSC Membership Services Committee

Reviews the membership structure and benefits in addition to providing recommendations on new services to support ADIA member companies across all aspects of their operations.

In addition to supporting the work of the Association, membership of an ADIA national committee is a great way to build a network of professionals within the industry who share your commitment to dental industry excellence.
